- 1. As a collegiate Panhellenic member, one will respectfully adhere to the laws and standards set by the Commonwealth of Massachusetts and Worcester Polytechnic Institute.
 - 1.1. All members are forbidden to consume alcoholic beverages, use cannabis products, and any illegal substances at any Panhellenic events organized by the Worcester Polytechnic Institute Panhellenic Association.
 - 1.2. Social events run by individual Panhellenic organizations that are not open to the campus shall abide by the rules and guidelines of said organization and must utilize certified vendors for alcohol distribution in accordance with applicable policies.
 - 1.2.1. This includes but is not limited to, formals, socials, and galas.
